

| THE NEXT GENERATION OF GLOBAL TECH CHAMPIONS

France continues to attract global investors looking to find innovative and high growth companies.

In 2021 we saw a record level of VC investment pour into startups and scaleups in France - €11.7B in total, with 897 VC deals, 8 Mega Rounds over €250M plus 15 over €100M and 11 new unicorns.

Our **French Tech Next 40/120** program supports French scaleups with the capacity to become world-class technology leaders. **120 French startups and scaleups** are selected each year to be part of the program. Selection criteria is based on potential for hypergrowth and fundraising capacity. The selection is open to all startup models (digital, deeptech, industrial) and all business sectors. The results speak for themselves.

According to a recent Roland Berger study, by 2025:

- 60% of their turnover will be generated abroad with a predicted growth rate of +40% each year
- they will account for 6% of the growth of France's GDP
- they will generate directly or indirectly 224,000 jobs
- 20-30 are expected to IPO at Euronext Paris with 1 joining the CAC
 40, the French stock market index.

Investment in French Tech companies has accelerated significantly in 2021, with total funding topping €11.7B this year, fueled by 65 deals of more than €40M. Investor interest in the French ecosystem is global, with 60% coming from top-tier VC firms in North America, Asia and across Europe all participating in major funding rounds.
